Exploring photogenic historical buildings, Morioka's downtown area is dotted with historical buildings, including modern architecture such as the "Old Morioka Bank (now the Iwate Bank Red Brick Building)" built in 1911 by the same designer as Tokyo Station, a group of townhouses reminiscent of the streets of the Edo period, and the ruins of Morioka Castle, where beautiful stone walls still remain.

Experience traditional crafts that are deeply rooted in daily life

When it comes to crafts that represent wate, "Nambu ironware" is the name. In particular, Nambu iron kettles are popular overseas as well, as "i'you make tea with boiled water, it will taste mellow." "Homespun" is a woolen fabric that is spun by hand into thread and then woven by hand. It is characterized by a gentle, warm texture that is full of air

If you're starting from the southern area of Iwate Prefecture...

The southern part of the prefecture starts from Hanamaki Airport. Iwate is dotted with historical and cultural attractions such as the World Heritage Site "Hiraizumi", the folklore village "Tono", and traditional performing arts such as the UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage "Hayachine Kagura". Another attraction is the large number of unique hot spring resorts such as "Hanamaki Onsenkyo".



You can also take a day trip to these unique hot springs!

Iwate is a treasure trove of hot springs. Among them, "Hanamaki Onsenkyo", which is easily accessible from Hanamaki Airport, is dotted with 12 hot springs and has a wide variety of accommodations, from traditional hot spring towns to modern hotels. There are many places where you can take a day trip to bathe, so you can enjoy "hot spring hopping".



If you start from Morioka Area...

Morioka, the largest city in Iwate Prefecture, was introduced second only to London in the 52 places to visit in 2023" announced by the New York Times. As described as a "gem of a city you can walk around," the cityscape, where nature and historical culture are in harmony, can be experienced even more charming by strolling around. "

Complete the "Three Great Noodles" Specialty of Morioka

Wankosoba is a bowl of soba noodles served in small portions that you keep eating until you are full. "Morioka Reimen" is a perfect combination of chewy noodles and soup with concentrated umami. "Morioka Jajamen" is wheat noodles mixed with a special meat miso. All of these are soul foods that continue to be loved by locals.

Experience the golden culture of the World Heritage Site "Hiraizumi"

Iwate Prefecture has three World Heritage Sites, the most in Japan along with Nara and Kagoshimal One of them, "Hiraizumi," is about an hour's drive from Hanamaki Airport. In addition to the five constituent assets including the Golden Hall of Chusonji Temple, a symbol of the golden culture, important related assets are scattered throughout the prefecture.
